Pop-up Plant, Produce and (gardening) Paraphernalia Sale

This sale will be on **Sunday 20 September** from 2-4pm at 62 Chantry Road. We have lots of plants that need to be cleared before the winter and we don't really want to compost them. We would also like to raise some more funds for Moseley in Bloom before the end of the season.

Please note the following guidelines:

- We will ask you to follow a one-way system and, if necessary, to queue in a social-distancing-fashion before coming in to the sale area.
- Please use the hand sanitiser provided
- Payment will be by donation into a container. We will not handle money.
- Please do not handle anything you do not intend to take away.
- Please wear a mask if possible
- If you have surplus plants, cuttings or seeds, fruit or vegetable produce or garden equipment that you do not want, these can be delivered to 62 Chantry Road any time from now and during the Pop-up Sale. If delivering before the Sale, please put them to the side of the drive.
- Please label plants and seeds.
- Bring your own bags and trays to take away your purchases

We will also have some special perennial herbs, generously donated by **Urban Herbs** who you may have seen at Moseley Farmers' Market. <https://urban-herbs.co.uk>

Our last sale, in June, raised over £300 for Moseley in Bloom so let's see if we can beat that in our last sale of the year.
